 - 5. The expenses towards TA/DA etc. of the official members in connection with the meetings of the Steering Committee will be borne by the respective Government/ Departments/ Institutions to which they belong. Non-official members will be entitled to travel only by Executive Class of Air India and their expenditure towards TA/DA (as admissible to Grade I officers of the Government of India) will be paid by the Planning Commission.
