Terms of Reference for engagement of Young Professional under the Plan Scheme-06.00.28- Expertise for Planning Process.

(i) Precise statement of Objectives:-

The Development Policy Division is engaged in the following:

- Monitoring the macro-economic parameters, policies and programmes of economic reforms.
- Doing research and suggesting changes in major policy areas.
- Performing the role of a nodal Division in respect of the Department of Food and
 Public Distribution and the Department of Consumer Affairs

The Planning Commission proposes to employ a full time Young Professional to handle the work in the Development Policy Division.

(ii) Outline of the tasks to be carried out:-

- Carrying out research and analysis of data on macroeconomic indicators for suggesting changes in economic policy for improving the service delivery system in the country.
- Preparation of briefs on various aspects of economic policy.

(iii) Schedule for completion of Tasks:-
