Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letter No. PD(P)-29/2009 dated 07.12.2009 of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, seeking approval of the Sectoral Break-up for the Annual Plan 2009-10 outlay of Rs.2100 crore. This include Rs.900 crore (grant) as Special Plan Assistance(including Rs. 105.31 crore for Border village illumination programme under PM's package and Rs.8.51 crore for Sprots Infrastructure). The plan outlay also includes another Rs.179.64 crore ACA for reconstruction of infrastructure damaged in flood.

- 2. The Scheme of Financing reflecting the above components of the Annual Plan 2009-10 is given at *Annexure-I*.
- 3. A statement showing the distribution of the outlay for Annual Plan 2009-10 among different heads and sub-heads of development, including earmarked outlays for PM's package, Reconstruction work of flood damaged infrastructure(ACA) is at *Annexure-II*.
- 4. Out of the total SPA of Rs. 900 crore(grant), provision of Rs. 105.31 crore for Border village illumination programme and Rs.8.51 crore for Sports Infrastructure have been earmarked. The balance SPA provision of Rs.786.18 crore (grant) has been shown against Planning, which will be redistributed to the respective sectors against priority projects/programmes and to meet the shortfall in the resources gap in various sectors with the approval of the Planning Commission. This would be reflected at the Revised Outlay stage. Rs.179.64 crore ACA for reconstruction of flood damaged infrastructure has been shown against Planning, which will be distributed among the various sectors as per the sanction letter dated 7.7.2008 at Revised Outlay stage. Activity specific earmarking of funds is given at Annexure-III
- 5. I am directed to invite your attention to the procedure for sending adjustment proposal and revision of outlays and to request you to send the adjustment proposal and proposal for revision of outlays, fully supported by Revised Scheme of Financing of Annual Plan 2009-10, together with appropriate justification before 31st January, 2010.
- 6. The programme/project implementation would be monitored by the State Government closely with a view to achieve the financial and physical targets.

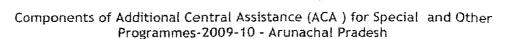
