Sir.

Kindly refer to the Govt. of Meghalaya Letter No. PLP.209/2009/Pt/303 dated 20<sup>th</sup> July.2010 proposing details of sectoral allocation of the approved outlay of Rs. 2230.00 crore for Annual Plan 2010-11, including SPA (grant) of Rs 500.00 crore

- 2. The Planning Commission conveys its approval of the proposed sectoral allocation, including earmarking of ACA/SPA as indicated in the statements enclosed (Annexure I & IV).
- The revised Scheme of Financing (SOF) of the approved Annual Plan 2010-11 is enclosed at **Annexure-I**
- 4. A statement showing the distribution of the approved sectoral allocation for Annual Plan 2010-11 among different sectors with earmarking of ACA/SPA, TFC, EAP and Others is at **Annexure II**, Allocation of one time ACA in **Annexure III**, Details of Earmarked amount in **Annexure IV**.
- The State Govt. should ensure that the State share for flagship programme is adequately provided. Failing, the State will lose Central Share accordingly.
- 5. The State Govt. would submit the detailed project proposals for approval of Planning Commission under one time ACA / SPA which will be sanctioned after the projects are cleared and approved by the Planning Commission.
- 6. The funds earmarked for SCSP/TSP could be placed at the disposal of the nodal Department which, in turn, will re-allocate the funds to the Sectoral Departments for implementing schemes under SCSP/TSP. The funds earmarked for SCSP/TSP could be placed under a separate budget Head/ Sub-Head for each implementing Department. **Physical and financial achievements on schemes**

under SCSP/TSP could be got verified as per the proforma circulated by Planning Commission vide DO letter No.M-13054/2/2005-BC dated 12.1.2006.

- 8. Attention is invited to the procedure for sending adjustment proposal and revision of outlays and to request State Govt. of Meghalaya to send the adjustment proposal and proposal for revision of outlays fully supported by the Revised Scheme of Financing for the Annual Plan 2010-11, if any, together with appropriate justification, before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2010
- 9. Statements showing actual expenditure incurred and the corresponding actual Scheme of Financing of the Annual Plan 2010-11 could be sent to the Planning Commission before 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2011.
- 10. The Plan Programmes need to be monitored closely with a view to achieve the financial and physical targets.
