
ABOUT PUDUCHERRY

ABOUT PUDUCHERRY

The Union Territory of Puducherry comprises 4 Regions namely Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. Puducherry and Karaikal regions are surrounded by Tamil Nadu. Karaikal is 135 kms. South of Puducherry and connected by Road & Rail. Mahe is an enclave of Kerala and is 650 kms. West of Puducherry. Yanam is an enclave of Andhra Pradesh and is 840 kms. North-East of Puducherry.

A. <u>Upgradation of 100 ITIs into Centre of Excellence with</u> Domestic Funding

- The Govt. ITI (Men), Pondicherry was taken up for Upgradation under the scheme during the year 2005 in the sector of Plastic Processing.
- So far 3 batches passed out from the institute and No. of candidates trained are 147.
- At present 43 trainees are under going training.

B. <u>Upgradation of 400 ITIs through World Bank Assistance</u>

- The Govt. ITI (Men), T.R. Pattinam, Karaikal was taken up for Upgradation under the scheme during the year 2008.
- Training is given in 6 Upgraded trades viz., Machinist, Turner, Welder, Instrument Mechanic, Mechanic (Motor Vehicle) and Mechanic (Diesel).
- ❖ 268 number of candidates are trained so far.

C. <u>Upgradation of 1396 Govt. ITIs through Public Private</u> <u>Partnership</u>

- At present 3 Govt. ITI (Women), Puducherry, Govt. ITI Nettapakkam, Puducherry & Govt. ITI for Women, T.R. Pattinam, Karaikal are covered under the scheme. Each ITI has received ` 2.5 crore from DGE&T and implementation is under process.
- Proposal has been sent to Govt. of India for inclusion of 1 more ITI viz., N.S.C.B. Govt.ITI, Yanam under the scheme.

D. Skill Development Initiative (SDI) Schemes

- Under the scheme 7 Govt. ITIs and 2 Private ITIs are registered as VTPs with RDAT, Chennai.
- ❖ The commencement of MES courses earlier was September 2009 and suspended as per DGE&T instruction for want of survey during May 2010.
- Now the MES courses have been commenced at Govt. ITIs.

CONVENING OF MEETING ON THE SKILL DEVELOPMENT MISSION

The State Skill Development Mission in this Union Territory of Puducherry is constituted under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister on 24-06-2010. 1st meeting was convened on 24-09-2010 and the 2nd meeting of State Skill Development Mission is proposed to be held shortly.

SKILL SURVEY & MAPPING

- As per the instruction of DGE&T, New Delhi, it has been decided to conduct Skill Survey & Mapping for the Union Territory.
- Tender for the Skill Survey work has been finalised and the work order will be issued shortly.
- The time limit for the completion of Skill Survey is 18 weeks.
- Based on the Survey Report, new trades / short-term courses will be started to cater to the needs of industries and also to increase the employment opportunities.

HURDLES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHEMES

- Lack of response for MES courses from the youth.
- Lack of response from industries / associations for the PPP scheme.
- Delay / Difficulties in obtaining approval of Govt. of India for the creation of post in ITIs.
- State Govt. has no power for creation of post. Due to lack of sufficient manpower, speedy implementation is affected.

WHAT ARE WE PLANNING TO DO?

- Increasing publicity campaign.
- Increasing awareness among the rural youth.
- Address the industries to train their workers unskilled and semiskilled.
- Address the Govt. Departments to sponsor the staff to upgrade their skills.
