• Skill Development Programme started in 2004 – 05.

 Each Line Department directed to organize trainings in their respective sector.

 2% of each Line Department's Plan budget earmarked for training. Directorate of Capacity Building established under the DOP in August 2007 as a single window for skill development.

Directorate placed under the Labour Department in April 2011

## Mandate of the Directorate –

## 1.Skill Development Scheme.

To organize vocational trainings for educated unemployed youth within the State and outside.

Since its establishment in 2007 up to the end of the financial year 2010-11, 1487 students have been provided training under the scheme at a cost of Rs.1171.28 lakhs(average of Rs.78,768.00 per student.

With the establishment of the **State Institute** of Capacity Building in 2009, the Directorate no longer organizes training and is merely an administrative unit.

2.To establish a **State Institute of Capacity Building** which would thereafter set up 31 **Livelihood Schools**.

The **State Institute of Capacity Building** was established in November 2009.

In the following 2 years, all 31 Livelihood Schools were set up and became functional.

25 different types of skills trainings are imparted in these School.

There is one Livelihood School in each Assembly Constituency.

In the 2 year of its life, the Livelihood Schools has trained 1819 students of whom 60% are employed through placement arrangements by service partners.

These schools are run in partnership with expert non-governmental service partners such as Basix Academy for Building Lifelong Employability, NewDelhi (BABLE), Manipal, etc.

The trainings provided in these schools are –

In the 11<sup>th</sup> Plan period,3306 students have been trained at a cost of Rs.2857.25 lakhs. Average cost per student – Rs.86,426.00.

Target for the 12<sup>th</sup> Plan is 9600 nos at an estimated cost of Rs.8905 lakhs.

Target for 2012-13 is 2000 at an estimated cost of Rs.1781 lakhs.
