1. The functions of the Development Policy Division are as follows :
 - (i) Monitoring of the macro-economic parameters.
 - (ii) Monitoring of policies and programmes of economic reforms.
 - (iii) Doing research and suggesting changes in major policy areas.
 - (iv) Performing the role of a nodal Division in respect of the Department of Food and Public Distribution.
 - (v) Preparation of briefs, reviews, notes on various aspects of economic policy matters.
2. The policy matters are considered within the frame given in the Plan document which has the approval of the National Development Council as well as the Central Government.
