Development Policy Division

- 1. The functions of the Development Policy Division are as follows:
 - (i) Monitoring of the macro-economic parameters.
 - (ii) Monitoring of policies and programmes of economic reforms.
 - (iii) Doing research and suggesting changes in major policy areas.
 - (iv) Performing the role of a nodal Division in respect of the Department of Food and Public Distribution.
 - (v) Preparation of briefs, reviews, notes on various aspects of economic policy matters.
- 2. The policy matters are considered within the frame given in the Plan document which has the approval of the National Development Council as well as the Central Government.
