Sub: Constitution of the State Level Steering Committee to monitor and guide activities under the UNDP-Planning Commission Project "Human Development: Towards Bridging Inequalities" - State Human Development Report

PREAMBLE:

The Government of Karnataka has been a forerunner in formulating and implementing programs and schemes to accelerate human development. It is exploring ways and mechanisms to support its human development efforts, and has prepared a proposal for collaboration under UNDP-Planning Commission Project-'Human Development: Towards Bridging Inequalities'. The project was approved by Planning Commission vide letter No. 0-14015/1/2012-SP-CO dated 13th July 2012.

The main goal of the project is to assess the status of human development in the State, identify trends in key indicators of human development and outline crucial human development issues with a focus on regional and social inequalities. The project will also provide technical support to design policy interventions that promote inclusive human development.

It is proposed to establish a State Level Steering Committee to monitor and guide the activities at the State Level under this Project. Hence the Order.



The Terms of Reference for the State Level Steering Committee will include:

- (i) Rendering advice on the outline of the report, selection of the HDR team, the overall timeline and work plan, and consultation process;
- (ii) Undertaking review of the first draft of the Report;
- (iii) Undertaking review and approval of the final draft;
- (iv) Rendering advice on the distribution and advocacy strategy

The term of the Steering Committee will be one year from the date of first meeting. The Steering committee will meet at least once in three months, and may hold special meetings, as required.

Non-official Members of the Steering Committee will be entitled allowance as follows:

- (i) Non official members are entitled for sitting fee of Rs. 4000- per day
